

IAITAM POSTPONES ACE CONFERENCE IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 CONCERNS

CANTON, OH – March 16th, 2020 – The International Association of IT Asset Managers (IAITAM) announced today that, for the first time in its history, the ACE conference scheduled for May 12-14 in Nashville has been postponed until further notice due to imminent concerns regarding COVID-19.

The association reports they did not come to the decision lightly.

Dr. Barbara Rembiesa, CEO and President of IAITAM said: “We take great pride in being able to offer the best ITAM education to our conference attendees every year. It really is one of our most beloved events and not just loved by our attendees but loved by us too.” Dr. Rembiesa also adding: “This is one of the hardest things we’ve ever had to do as a company, but we truly believe it is in everyone’s best interest.”

IAITAM stresses the need to put the health and safety of conference attendees first.

The association is following all provided COVID-19 guidelines from the CDC, The Ohio Department of Health, The Tennessee Department of Health as well as the local health department in Nashville.

“We are doing what is best for our attendees who would be in Nashville and doing what is best for our employees who would travel there from Ohio.” Said Dr. Rembiesa, “There are people coming from all over so there are a lot of moving parts. Ultimately, we have to put people’s safety first.”

IAITAM is working closely with the conference venue to secure a new date for the event and will provide updates as soon as they are known.
