

At IAITAM we understand that not everyone is 100% comfortable with taking an exam. For some, it's been a long time since your last test. Others may have always struggled with nervousness and anxiety prior to examination day.

In either case, this document is designed to help demystify the exam process and promote a more relaxed environment that empowers a student to be their most confident best!

To start, we will discuss the design intent and how the exam came to be created:



Each class consists of 3 primary components, apart from CITAM. These three components are the Certification Manual, the Certification Presentation, and the Certification Exam.

Concerning the exam, the test questions are created from both the Manual as well as the Presentation. Every question will exist within the course materials. This means that with an open book test, every piece of information you need to achieve a passing score of 85% are at your fingertips!

Now, let's take a peek at what the test will look like as well as the different types of questions you will be asked:

A Multiple-Choice question is often the standard question a student will be asked. Multiple answers are provided for the question, and the student is expected to select the best applicable answer.

### Multiple Choice Question Example

Which one of the following options is a fruit?

- Apple
- Cabbage
- Meatloaf

Correct	Choices
V	Apple
	Cabbage
	Meatloaf

A Multiple Response question will have "Select all that apply" attached somewhere in the question. Students are to select each answer that applies to the question.

### Multiple Response Question Example

Find the apples from the options listed. (Select all that apply)

- Red Delicious
- Yellow Delicious
- Granny Smith
- Avocado
- Rice

Correct	Choices
V	Red Delicious
V	Yellow Delicious
V	Granny Smith
	Avocado
	Rice

Matching questions are fun! Here, students should match correct items together and on the screen they will snap together like puzzle pieces!

### Matching Question Example

Match the following fruits to their color:

Banana	Yellow
Red Delicious	Red
Granny Smith	Green

Item	Match
Banana	Yellow
Red Delicious	Red
Granny Smith	Green

Yes/No questions function identically to True and False questions. A statement will be made and the student needs to select whether they agree or disagree with the statement.

### Yes or No Question Example

Meatloaf is a fruit.

True  
 False

Correct	Choices
	Yes
V	No

Lastly, a Sequence question is designed to test whether the student understands what order a statement should follow. These questions will only have one correct order, and the answers are dragged into the appropriate order that corresponds with the missing words in the statement provided.

### Sequence Question Example

Arrange the following fruits in alphabetical order:

1. Apples
2. Bananas
3. Cantaloupe
4. Dates

Correct Order	
1	Apples
2	Bananas
3	Cantaloupe
4	Dates

With an understanding of the exam, how it was created, where to find answers, what it looks like, and the questions that will be asked, students have all the tools needed to be prepared!
