

- Burn Out: Overly skilled workers taking on responsibility for endless tasks in order to complete jobs
- COVID
- Lured to competition

- Failure to clear pre-hire screening

- Pre-screened, typically done by the organization that is placing the employee








#### Different Doesn't Define Worth

As example: Autism spectrum disorder is a diagnosis that is characterized by differences from the general population in the area of social skills, and communication skills, as well as the presence of certain behaviors which may look atypical from other people. These behaviors are known as restrictive or repetitive behaviors.

A person with autism has their own unique strengths and abilities.

A 2018 study performed by Accenture discovered that companies who hired individuals with disabilities saw a 72% increase in productivity, higher profit margins, and higher net incomes.

The study also found that non-disabled employees who worked alongside disabled employees became more aware of inclusivity and recognized how to make their work environment more accessible.
