The IAITAM **Certified Asset Management Professional (CAMP)** course provides a comprehensive introduction to the best practices and processes of IT Asset Management (ITAM). - 7. **Secure Executive Support for IT Initiatives:** Advocate for and sustain executive management support for IT-related projects and strategies through alignment with business objectives.
- 8. **Promote Asset Management Awareness:** Develop and implement communication strategies to increase employee awareness and understanding of Asset Management practices.
- 9. **Bridge ITAM and ITSM Disciplines:** Provide thought leadership to integrate and align IT Asset Management (ITAM) and IT Service Management (ITSM) for optimal results.
